I am contacting you today at the Los Angeles Office regarding H.R. 5656: Feed the Future Global Food Security Act of 2014. H.R. 5656 is a federal bill in the House of Representatives and was introduced to a congressional committee on September 18, 2014 for study. If H.R. 5656 is released by the committee, your voice in the House of Representatives can affect the outcome of the bill throughout the voting, debating, and amending process to potentially move H.R. 5656 to the Senate.

I am an undergraduate at the University of California, Davis, studying Clinical Nutrition. I have a passion for justice and equality in the world, and dream about how the prevalent issue of world hunger could be approached. H.R. 5656 addresses this topic by taking a step in trying to reduce global poverty and hunger in developing countries. This food security and nutrition strategy is titled Feed the Future Initiative (FTF). A few policies that FIF promotes are agricultural developments to transform economies, improving post-harvest storage to reduce waste, and expanding access of diverse and quality foods to enhance nutrition. H.R. 5656 further addresses strategies of reducing poverty and hunger in developing countries by implementing partnerships and institutions in the world's poorest counties to provide nutrition education and emphasized care for maternal women and children.
